## NOTES ON TODAY'S MUSIC

Alfred Hollins was an English-born organist, pianist, composer, and teacher whose life spanned the mid-19<sup>th</sup> through the mid-20<sup>th</sup> centuries. Visually impaired from birth, he was educated at the Royal National College for the Blind, where he later taught. His teachers included Hans von Bülow (piano) and E.J. Hopkins (organ). His first professional church appointments were at St. John's Church in Redhill and Upper Norwood Presbyterian. Later, upon hearing him play, Reverend Hugh Black of Free St. George's Presbyterian in Edinburgh, Scotland, persuaded the authorities of the church to allow the installation of an organ and offered Hollins a job on the spot. Hollins remained there for the rest of his life even as he also undertook an international concert career that frequently led him to the United States, South Africa, Australia, and New Zealand.

*A Trumpet Minuet* is Hollin's best known and most often performed organ composition. It uses the structure of music used to accompany a popular French social dance as the basis of a piece that showcases the organ's solo trumpet stops.
